St. Thomas-St John District Schools Dismiss Early on Oct. 12

ST. THOMAS, USVI – Four schools in the St. Thomas-St. John District will dismiss at 1 p.m. on Oct. 12 due to equipment failure at the Charlotte Amalie High School kitchen that supplies meals to the school campuses: Ulla F. Muller Elementary School, Jane E. Tuitt Elementary School, Joseph Sibilly Elementary School and Sugar Apple Pre-Kindergarten (Monroe Annex).

Students will be fed a healthy snack prior to their departure from the campuses.

Meal distribution sites that are also impacted include Paul M. Pearson Gardens Community Center, Oswald Harris Court Community Center, Winston Raymo Community Center, and Lovenlund Housing Development.

The Department of Education will provide an update on the status of the schools and distribution sites for Oct. 13.
