

CHS SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY



FEMALE STUDENT UNIFORM

- **Skirt:** A knife or box pleated maroon skirt with a waistband of not more than two inches should be worn.



- The length of the skirt must reach the top of the knee or longer.
- The back of the skirt must reach the bend at the back of the knee.
- No lace, frills, or ornamentations including colored thread will be allowed on the school uniform skirt.
- Additionally, no wrap skirts, shorts, or bibs will be permitted on campus.



- **Blouse:** White cotton short-sleeve button down at the front with collar or loose-fitting white polo shirt, no ornamentations.
- **Pants:** Maroon full length pants with a waistband of no more than two inches.
 - **NOT Allowed:** cargo, oversized, form fitting, capri or low-rise pants.
 - Dickies style pants also **NOT** allowed.
- **Socks:** Ankle to knee high white or maroon with no ornamentations.
- **Shoes:** No fluorescent or bright multi-colored sneakers or shoes.
 - Preferred: red/ maroon, black, white sneakers. No slippers, slides, mules, high heels, or boots are allowed on campus. **NO CROCS**
- **Jewelry:** One watch, one pair of earrings (no large hoops, balls, or designs), one small chain with one small pendant, and one bracelet. Absolutely no rings are allowed.



MALE STUDENT UNIFORM

- **Pants:** Plain khaki trousers with belt buckled not below the waistline.



- Pants should have front and rear pockets –
- **NOT Allowed** - no cargo pants, oversized pants, or extra printed or embroidered designs. The length of the pant should not pass the sole of the shoes.

- **Shirt:** White short-sleeve button down at the front with collar or white loose fitting polo shirt.
- **Shoes:** No fluorescent or bright multi-colored sneakers or shoes. Preferred: red/ maroon, black, white sneakers. No slippers or boots are allowed on campus. **NO CROCS.**
- **Socks:** Black, brown, or white must be worn
- **Jewelry:** One watch, one small chain with one small pendant, no more than one pair of earrings, and one bracelet. Absolutely no rings are allowed.





DRESS CODE POLICY APPLICABLE TO ALL STUDENTS:

- Only seniors may wear solid maroon ties.
- Only seniors may wear maroon vests.
- Only seniors may wear class rings.
- Only seniors may wear class shirts on Thursdays.
- Athletic shoes will not be accepted under any circumstances in any vocational educational classes.
- Only white/grey undershirts are permitted.
- No caps, hats, bandanas, stocking caps or du-rags should be worn on campus.
 - (If headwear is mandated by religious beliefs, the school needs a letter from the religious leader).
- No sunglasses unless prescribed by a licensed physician.
- Absolutely no jeans or pants made with denim will be allowed.
- No windbreakers/jackets except on rainy days.
 - The jacket must be zipped/buttoned straight down in the front. Big bulky jackets and excessively long coats are not allowed.
- Belts must be worn with pants. No oversized, large buckles, or name designs will be allowed. No multicolored belts or excessive ornamentations.
- Your pants must be at your natural waist.
 - Pants length must be long but should not exceed shoe soles.
- **ABSOLUTELY NO PULLOVERS OR HOODIES.**
- Students giving class presentations or on-the-job training (OJT) dress code:
 - Girls: Formal business attire and appropriate walking shoes.
 - Boys: Semi-formal business attire

Violations of the uniform policy in part or its entirety will result in disciplinary action, to include being sent home until proper adjustments are made or the item in violation of the policy is taken away.
